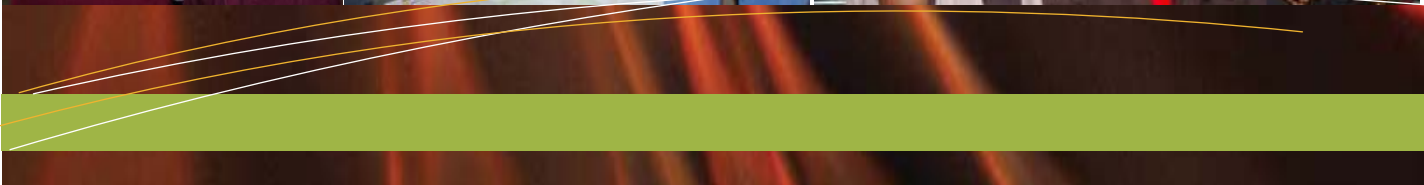
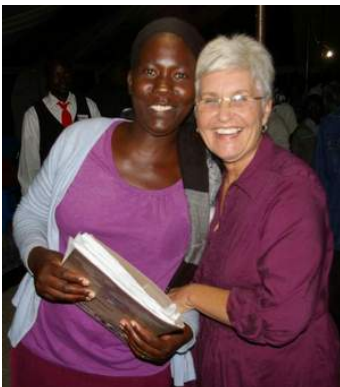

SEWER PLANT:

Sonney and Abisai dug the hole by hand and we finally got a backhacter to get the hole on the right level according to plan. The concrete floor was done this week, and the walls are busy going up.



FOUNDATIONS OF FIRST ROOMS

The foundations of first 6 rooms were dug and we hope to start with the building of foundations soon.



SAFARI TENT:

The tent was able to accommodate sixteen people during the School of Preaching in May. The tent still need a fly sheet for protection against the sun but it is operational.



CABINS:

Both cabins are used for accommodation every night which not only serve ministry needs, but also generate income so that we were able to buy 10 bunk beds to accommodate the pastors for the training.

- **JUNE & JULY:** Digging of foundations of rooms and construction sewer plant at El Shaddai. Skosh & Marlene and staff will continue with the project while we will be ministering in Malawi during July.
- **JUNE 26-30:** Hennie & Sonney will leave on Monday to Thodonza village, Venda to do the digging and concrete work of foundations of the church building.
- **JULY 13 – 30:** Departing on 13th by road via Mozambique to Ngabu village, Malawi. We expect 150 Delegates (men, women, youth leaders) will be attending the training that will be held from 25-29 July 2011. Pray for the Holy Spirit to *“open their understanding, that they might comprehend the Scriptures.”* Luke 22:44 To find the Truth, the Way and Life in Him.
- **AUG 3-5:** Hands of Hope Sewing Training at El Shaddai. Ellen McDonald and Rina will be teaching special sewing techniques.
- **AUG 20 – SEPT 4:** The team from Cedargrove BC, Stamping ground, Ky, USA will come to assist with the construction of rooms at El Shaddai and will be ministering in the afternoons to children and evening crusade in the village.
- **SEPT 12 – 30:** Church building project & Crusade, Thodonza, Venda with Pastor Richard Hamlet, GMF.
- **OCT 3-7:** Leadership Training – Bright Star Module 3 with pastors of SA, Malawi and Zimbabwe
- **OCT 24-28:** Leadership Training – Bright Star Modules 1,2,3 WalvisBay, Namibia.
- **OCT – NOV:** Completion of 6 rooms at El Shaddai Equipping Centre.
